Children also created their own Prayer Flags inscribed with positive thoughts of Peace, Hope, Happiness, Love ,Health to share with the world. Prayer Flags are the essential part of Sikkim Culture.

The objective of this activity is to develop a strong sense of bond and belongingness between the two partnering states. These activities also make the young children of the two states more aware about each other's lesser known facts. These activities also sensitise the student community to respect and appreciate the state's indigenous and local culture and history.
