Proceedings of the 20th P.T.C.C. meeting held on 16.11.2019 at 5.00 p.m. in the school premises.

PROCEEDINGS

20(1) At the outset **Mr.Sitikantha Pati**, the Supervisor of Class-XI and XII extended a warm greetings to all the members of the PTCC. Further, the proceedings of the last meeting held on **10.08.2019** circulated among the members through e-mail along with action taken report was discussed thoroughly and approved.

20(2) **Mr Pati** apprised the parents about the examination policy of Class-X for the academic session 2019-20. He also narrated about the promotion criteria of Class XI as mentioned below.

- A minimum of 33% marks in theory and practical separately is required in all subjects to be declared as 'pass'.
- Failure in any two or more subjects will be considered as 'fail'.
- Failure in one subject will be placed in compartment and the exam. will be conducted within one week. Failure to get a pass mark will be considered as 'fail'.

Further, he apprised that there is a large gap between the methodologies of teaching and the contents of the syllabi of classes X and XI. Hence, the academic advisory committee of the school has decided to commence the classes for Std. XI from **1st week of April** to bridge the gap. Otherwise, it will be too late to finish the course in time as far as our experience goes.

He also informed the members about the internal admission procedure for our Std-X students to Std-XI for the session 2019-20 as below.

"Admission was based on the performance of students in Pre-Board exam with a cut off of 85% marks for Science Stream in Science and Maths separately; 75%marks for commerce and 65% marks for humanities in aggregate."

He also wanted the opinion of Hon'ble members to finalise the criteria for the session 2020-21.

In the process of discussion, one of the members wanted to know whether the above criteria was universally applicable for all the four DAVs in Bhubaneswar or not. It was apprised that the above criteria was meant for our school only.

In order to reduce the huge gap of 10% between Science and Commerce one of the members proposed to fix the benchmark of 80% for Science. Another member also proposed to include English for selection of Science. In this context **Mr. Sitikantha Pati** explained about the relevance of taking Science and Mathematics subjects for selection of +2 Science. He said, all the major subjects of +2 Science i.e. Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Mathematics are based on the above two subjects in Class X level. The Principal also apprised the members that above such criteria will make the students more serious about their study and enhance their spirit of practice for forthcoming Board examination.

After a thread bare discussion it was unanimously resolved to accept the procedure of selection for Class XI(insiders) as finalized for previous year 2019-20. The same are as under:

- The selection will be made as per the performance in Sahoday Pre-Board Examination.
- The cut off mark for Class-XI Science- **85%** in Mathematic & Science subjects separately.
XI Commerce- **75%** in aggregate.
XI Humanities- **65%** in aggregate.

20.(3) The Academic Performance of students in Term-1 examination of School was presented by **Mrs. P.Anuradha**, Academic Supervisor for Class III to V and the same was discussed vividly.

But at the same time they expressed their dissatisfaction for the result of Class-IX and X in which the school average are less than 80%. In this context **Mr.Ranjan Kumar Swain** narrated that It has happened only due to inclusion of some difficult subjects in Term-1 portion and the sudden change of question pattern in comparison to the previous class.

One of the parent members stressed on the practical way of teaching for middle class students, especially for Science subject. The same was noted for action in spirit.

The result analysis of Term-1 for Class XI & XII of the school was exhibited by **Mr.Sitikantha Pati**, Academic Supervisor of Class XI & XII and the same was discussed vividly.

- **Master Aditya Kumar Das** of Class-V-C has got 3rd prize in Open Odisha Chess Championship and participating National championship held at Indira Gandhi which will be held at Indira Gandhi Sports Complex, New Delhi(7 to 25 November,2019)
- **Master Bismit Sahoo** of Class VII-B has got the cash award of one Lakh as achieving the All India Rank-1 in ANTHE conducted AAKash Institute.

20.(5) Any other points with permission to the chair-

- One of the members proposed Drinking water bell Times before the recess period in order to aware students for drinking water. The same was noted and it was decided to make the students apprised through the teachers just 5 minutes before the recess

- Some of the members proposed to make provision of purified normal water for students instead of Cold water which is more harmful for their body.
- The Principal apprised the members that the school has adopted the Old-Age Home at Sunderpada and provide all possible help as and when required.
- **Mr. Krushna Chandra Sethy**, the parent member of Class-I proposed to construct a Shelter Area/Rest Shed beside the School Gate No-1 so that parents can take shelter in rainy season. The same was not accepted due to lack of permission for construction on the govt. land and it will be the station for different anti-social activities.
- **Mr. Sethy** also proposed to close the School as when the Govt. declares holidays due to natural calamities. Adding to the point, the Principal informed to the august body that it has already been decided to close the school as and when there is a Govt. order.
