## PROCEEDINGS

At the outset , the Principal extended a warm welcome to all the members present in the PTCC meeting.

- 6(1). The proceedings of the last meeting held on 22/01/2016 were read out, discussed thoroughly and confirmed.
- 6(2). The result analysis of CBSE Class XII Examination- 2016 of the school was exhibited by Sri Sitikantha Pati, Supervisor Class XII and discussed vividly. He also perused the comparison of result from half yearly to Annual Examination 2016. Highlight of the result are as follows.

6(3) Principal expressed her inability to present the Audited Report in the meeting for the Session 2015-16 because the same was not completed till the day of meeting. After completion of report the same will be uploaded in our school website.

6(4). Since the School is on the doorsill of 25 years of its existence during the session 2016-17 , so Silver Jubilee Function started from the foundation day i.e. from 01.05.2016. Few glimpses of Silver Jubilee Celebrations , logo and Mascot were shown to the PTCC members. Principal madam expressed her heartfelt thanks to the hon'ble members and all the parents as well for their whole – hearted co-operation to make the inaugural occasion of Silver Jubilee a grand success. She requested to the members that as the month of May is very hot , the valedictory ceremony of Silver Jubilee will be celebrated during January 2017 in view of the good weather conditions. She expressed that the dignitaries of the celebration Dr. Poonam Suri, President and Dr. Nisha Peshin , Director , PS(II), DAV College Managing Committee, New Delhi were highly pleased not only for the function but also for the involvement of the parents.

6(5). Mrs Smaranika Patnaik supervisor of Classes VI to VIII presented the slides of the result analysis of Std III to Std VIII and showed some glimpses of various activities conducted inside and outside of the school. She also informed about the activities on "No Book Day". She also presented the comparative result analysis of SA- I with SA-2 from the classes III to VIII. Some parents regretted for the poor performance in Mathematics and Science especially in higher classes. The same was explained by the principal madam that such deviation occurred due to memory based and content based preparation, the student's lack of interest and input differences in higher classes. Some members sought to get the phone number of class teachers to clarify some doubts for their children. Members had also suggested that since the school is being closed from the month of April every year due to severe hot, the session of the school should start earlier i.e. from the month of March as soon as result are declared. Principal madam assured them to consider this matters in the next session specially for higher classes .

Mr. Ranjan Kumar Swain , Supervisor of Class IX & X showed the comparative result analysis of SA – I with SA-II . He presented some slides about various activities conducted inside and outside of the school. After going through the result, the members expressed their same displeasure on the poor performance of Maths and Science in class IX specially in SA- I . Again it was explained by the principal that due to our standardized question papers and proper evaluation system the result in SA-I is not impressive, however the students perform well in Board Examination due to remedial classes. She also requested them to send their children for remedial classes regularly. Specially the students of class IX to XII perform better in the Annual Examination than the half yearly examination.
